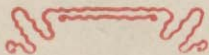

GYMNASIUM.

All boys, except those who are medically exempt, are required to attend the Gymnasium for instruction. The Gymnasium is open for voluntary exercise and for private lessons in Boxing and Fencing on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons. Competitions take place in the Lent Term for the Public Schools Pair the House Challenge Cup, the School Eight, and for Boxing and Fencing. Prizes are given by the Headmaster, the Old Tonbridgian Society, Mr. H. A. L. Rudd, O.T., Messrs. Stokoe, Floyd, Whitby, David, Earl and Roche. The Gymnasium is under the superintendence of Mr. Earl.

SCHOOL REGISTER.

The new edition of the Register of Tonbridge School is published by Rivingtons, price 10s., and may be obtained through any bookseller. For the successful completion of this arduous undertaking Mr. H. E. Steed, O.T. and Honorary Secretary of the O.T. Society, has earned the gratitude of all connected with the School. It contains a record of the 5,200 members of the School from 1820 to 1910, together with many matters of general interest, including lists of honours, of School teams, and many important details of the history of the School and of its more prominent members. No pains have been spared in the effort to make this record accurate in all its details.

OFFICERS' TRAINING CORPS.

The School Cadet Corps forms part of the Junior Division of the Officers Training Corps. Its authorised establishment is 360—and consists of 2 Companies. There are Company and Recruit Drills each week, attendance being compulsory.

Musketry Instruction is given at the Armoury and Miniature Range in the School Grounds as well as at the Range on Castle Hill, Pembury Road. Cadets are also trained in Signalling.

The MacDermott Mitchell Challenge Cup, presented by the late Mr. C. T. Mitchell, in memory of his son, is held by the House Detachment which shows the highest efficiency. The House Challenge Cup for Shooting (Pairs) was presented by Mr. L. H. Hansard. The Challenge Cup for the best average in Matches was presented by Lieut.-Col. C. E. Warner, O.T. The Governors of the School presented the Goldberg Cup, to be held by the marksman making the highest score in the Ashburton competition.

The Simpson Shield for the best House at Shooting was presented to the School in memory of the late Capt. A. H. Simpson—a former officer.

Uniforms and Accoutrements are provided from the Corps Funds. The term's subscription for each Cadet is 10/-, and extra charges are made for railway expenses and Camp.

All enquiries, applications for membership, &c., should be addressed to the Officer Commanding, Captain H. S. Vere Hodge.

GAMES.

The Games of the School are managed by the Games Committee, which consists of the Head Boy, Captain of Cricket, Captain of Football, Racquets and Fives Secretary or Boat Captain, and Athletic or Swimming Secretary according to the Term. The various Houses also elect representatives, who meet to discuss House interests. The finance is managed by Mr. Aston, who also exercises a general supervision.

MUSIC AND CHOIR.

Those who wish to learn Organ, Piano, Harmony, Singing, or Violin must give their names to Mr. Stewart at the beginning of Term.

All new boys' voices are tried for the Choir at the beginning of the Term. Full Choir practice takes place at 2.45 on Thursdays, and on Sundays at 10.15. The Choral Society meets on Wednesdays at 5 during the Michaelmas and Lent Terms. Fee, 6s. for the two Terms. The Orchestra meets for practice on Tuesday afternoons in the Museum.

ART SCHOOL.

There are two divisions for the purpose of instruction in Art, the Upper and Lower School. Mr. C. T. Dodd has charge of the Lower School, where all the preliminary subjects are taught—Freehand, Model, Army Drawing, etc.

In the Upper School, Mr. M. A. Buckinaster has charge of the advanced work, which includes such subjects as Mechanical and Architectural Drawing, Perspective, Design, Black and White for reproduction, Painting, etc. In the Architectural Class boys are expected to take the Preliminary Examination of the Institute of British Architects, and to prepare their drawings for the first part of the Intermediate Examination. There are no fees for instruction in Drawing.

OLD TONBRIDGIAN SOCIETY.

The annual subscription is 5/-, life-membership fee, £3. The Society gives prizes for games; provides an extra cricket professional; presents books to the School Library; defrays the expenses of the Society's register; meets annually at dinner and entertains guests; promotes mutual intercourse amongst O.T.'s, and keeps them in touch with the School. The Hon. Sec. is Mr. H. E. Steed, 90, South Croxted Road, West Dulwich, S.E.

BOAT CLUB.

Boys who wish to join the Club should apply to Mr. Griffith. Candidates have to obtain the consent of their Parents and House Master; they must pass a medical and a swimming test, and be accepted by the Boat Club Committee. Membership is at present limited to fifty. The subscription is Two Guineas per annum, payable in advance to Mr. Griffith, Hon. Treasurer. The Rowing Season includes Summer Term, and parts of the Lent and Michaelmas Terms. Races are arranged with other Schools and Clubs. There is a House Challenge Cup, and a Regatta is held at the end of the Summer Term. Cricket is voluntary for Members of the Club.

WORKSHOPS.

The various Workshops are under the superintendence of Mr. Earl, to whom application for admission should be made. Besides the special classes held during school hours, the workshops are open for voluntary work from 2 to 6 o'clock on half-holidays, during free time on whole school-days, and from 7 to 8.30 on Saturday nights, provided house-leave has been obtained and at least two hours' voluntary work has been done in the previous week. The names of all voluntary workers must appear in this Calendar each Term, and hence application cannot be entertained after the first Monday of Term. All boys are required to make working-drawings before undertaking any work. No one is admitted to the Engineering Workshop before he has acquired some proficiency in Pattern Making or Carpentry, and has also made himself familiar with the use of Working Drawings.

SHORTHAND, TYPEWRITING, &c.

Instruction is given by Mr. H. J. Pearson in Shorthand (Pitman's), for a small fee, and he is willing to make arrangements for lessons in Typewriting and Book-keeping.

SCHOLARSHIPS, &c.

In June this year, an Examination is held for the following Scholarships:—Two new Judd scholarships, one of £100, and one of £80 per annum. One Judd Scholarship of £40 per annum; about seven Foundation Scholarships of £30 or £21 per annum. Applications must be made before the last day of May to the Headmaster, School House, Tonbridge. There are twenty Leaving Exhibitions, five of which (four of £75 and one of £30 per annum in value) are awarded by the Governors every year, and are tenable for four years.

THE LIBRARY.

All boys may borrow books from the Library under the rules to be obtained from the Librarian. The Library is open as a Reading-room on week-days at all times, and on Sundays from 3 to 5 p.m. The Library contains over 5,000 volumes. Mr. Ash is the Librarian.

DEBATING SOCIETY.

The Society is limited to 25 members, meetings taking place every alternate Wednesday during the Term at 8.30 p.m. in the School Library. Admission to the Society is by election only. Those desirous of attending debates or of becoming members should give in their names to one of the Committee. President: C. H. Evans.

THE OBSERVATORY.

A valuable Telescope made by Cooke, of York, has been presented to the School by J. and W. Hartree, O.T.'s. It possesses a 6-inch object glass, and the usual accessories of such an instrument.

RACQUET COURT.

The Racquet Court was built in memory of the late J. W. Dale, O. T. Mr. Stewart is in control of the Court. A silver racquet presented by the late Mr. W. M. Greig, in the names of G. L. and A. W. Greig, O. T.'s, is held by the best House Pair. C. Hull is the professional.

SWIMMING BATH.

The Swimming Bath, 200ft. long and 40ft. broad, is a short distance from the School. Mr. Roche and Mr. Fobester are Instructors in Swimming, and every boy is required to learn.

CHAPEL DECORATION FUND.

The main portion of the new Chapel was completed and consecrated in May 1902. The remainder of the building was finished in December, 1908. The fabric itself has been provided by the Governors from the funds of the Foundation; but the provision of stained-glass windows and the decoration of the interior is being carried on by the aid of voluntary donations, and it is hoped that successive generations will contribute liberally to the Decoration Fund. Subscriptions may be sent to Mr. C. H. Crofts, the Honorary Secretary, or to a House Master.

THE TONBRIDGIAN.

Two numbers of the School Magazine are published every Term. The annual subscription is 4s. 6d., by post, 5s., or £1 for five years, and is paid to the Hon. Treasurer, Mr. H. R. Stokoe, Park House. Back numbers can be obtained by subscribers on application to the Treasurer. Contributions must be written on one side of the paper only. The name and address of the writer must be given, but need not be published. Contributions should be given or sent to the Editors, W. Porter and G. D. Hale.

SCHOOL MISSION.

The School Mission was founded in 1883, in the Parish of St. Pancras. This Parish has a strong claim upon the School, because the School property, from which the income of the School is derived, is situated in it. The School Mission provides £100 yearly for the stipend of a curate, and helps generally in the work of the Parish. The Funds of the Mission depend on the yearly subscriptions of Old Boys and on the collections made in the School at the beginning of each Term.
